## Ways to Use Big God Big Questions

Big God Big Questions is a curriculum, not a program. That is, the curriculum provides a course of study that has a beginning, a middle, and an end. The goal of the curriculum is to help you prepare your confirmands to make a profession of faith before your session and congregation. The curriculum offers many ideas for adapting the course to your Confirmation program. Here are some other ways to use Big God Big Questions in your context.

- Use the Teacher's Guide to plan for twelve ninety-minute sessions or twenty-four forty-five-minute sessions.
- Use the "101" activities to design a pre-Confirmation retreat/overnight or plan an eight-session pre-confirmation study. Use the activities when questions arise in your class. Also use them in your congregation's educational ministry.
- Use the infographics as indicated in the session plans, as visual aids for the session and other groups in the congregation, or as content for church bulletin boards.
- Use the videos in class as indicated in the session plans. Make the videos available to mentors and parents/caregivers to be used in Home/Mentor Guide conversations. Play the videos during a Confirmation retreat/overnight.
- Use the BIG Journal as indicated in the session plans. Give the BIG Journals to the confirmands during a Confirmation enrollment liturgy during a worship service.
- Use closing worship activities in the curriculum during the session examination and the Confirmation worship service.
