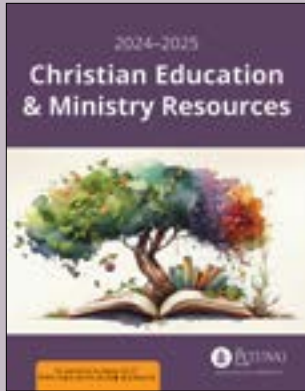

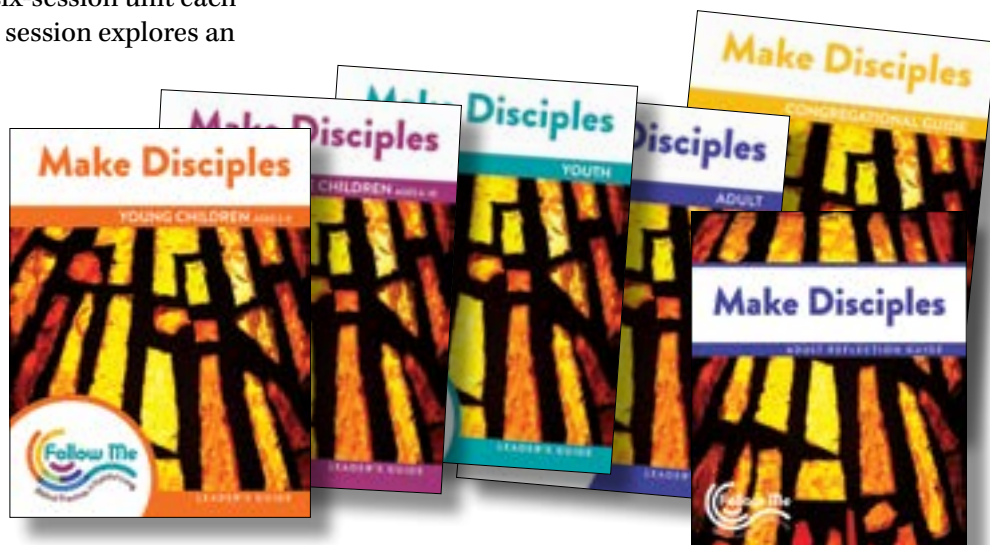

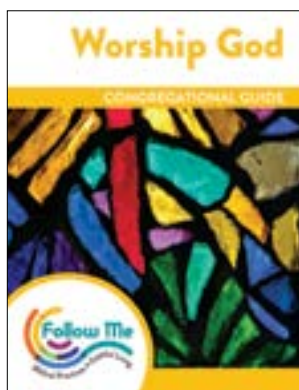

CONGREGATIONAL GUIDE

The *Congregational Guide* provides materials for any church leader to make connections with the practice, congregational worship, and everyday life. Faith communities with a limited educational program may use this resource to plan a congregational focus on each practice. The *Congregational Guide* includes:

Foundational Essay

Each practice contains a foundational essay written by a biblical or theological scholar. The essay provides a deep dive into the practice—where it is found in the Bible and how the community has practiced it then and now. An aspect or dimension of the practice for each session is highlighted along with biblical texts that illuminate it. Preachers may wish to develop a sermon series based on these texts. Adults and leaders seeking more depth may wish to read these essays. They are included in each leader's guide and the *Adult Reflection Guide*.



Worship Helps

Two-sided page for each session offers hymns and songs, ideas for ways to incorporate the practice into worship, and suggestions for parts of the worship liturgy.

Café Discussion Guides

Each session includes a two-sided page with activities and discussion prompts. These no-prep, easy-to-lead sessions are perfect for college groups, young adults, women's and men's groups, and church sessions or councils.

Intergenerational Session

Each unit features one intergenerational session that can be used with the whole church family before, during, or at the end of each unit.

Practicing the Practice at Home

A two-sided reproducible page for each unit facilitates practicing the practice with the whole family. The *Young Children Leader's Guide* and *Multiage Children Leader's Guide* also include this helpful tool.

Children's Worship Leaflets

For each session of the unit, a two-sided reproducible page includes ideas for practicing the practice, a puzzle or game, an adapted Bible story, and a coloring picture.

LEADER'S GUIDE

Session Plan

The flow of the session is the same for all ages and the intergenerational session found in the *Congregational Guide*.

- **Getting Started** provides an opening ritual for each session.
- **Introducing the Practice** invites participants to encounter an aspect of the practice.
- **Finding the Practice in the Bible** explores how the practice was lived by Jesus (Gospels), understood by his faith tradition (Hebrew Scriptures), and carried on by his followers (New Testament).
- **Finding the Practice All Around Us** (for children) or **Finding the Practice Then and Now** (for older age groups) names how the practice has been lived out by Christians through the centuries and where we see it today in our worship, community, and world.
- **Practicing the Practice** provides activities to live out this practice in our daily lives.
- **Following Jesus** sends participants out to follow Jesus.

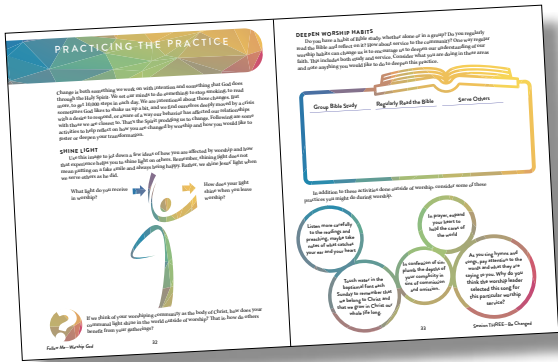
Activity Symbols

ADULT REFLECTION GUIDE

Think of the *Adult Reflection Guide* as a workbook or journal. It has the same flow of the session as other age groups but is filled with information about the practice, engaging adults through study, reflection questions, space for writing or drawing, and suggestions for practicing the practice. It is available in print from PC(USA) Store or as an ebook on Amazon.

The *Adult Reflection Guide* may be used in an adult study group along with the *Adult Leader's Guide*. It is also a great resource for individuals who wish to learn about a practice as a self-guided study or who are unable to attend group meetings.

CONVERSATION STARTER VIDEOS

Conversation starter videos for adults are used with the *Adult Leader's Guide* to promote conversation and provide more in-depth explanation of each practice and each aspect or session. The videos feature the writer of the foundational essay discussing their essay in further detail, and they can be used to enhance a session with a small group of adults.

In each session, these pages help the leader understand the story and how it relates to today's world, the spiritual lives of children, and the spiritual lives of adults.



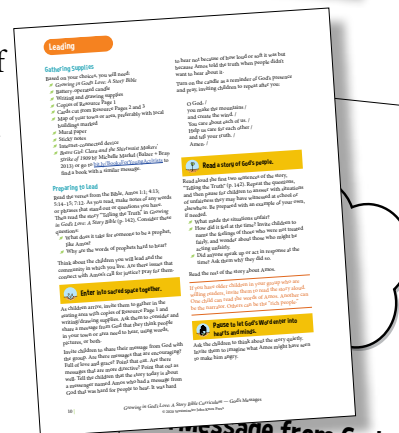
Intergenerational and Home Ideas

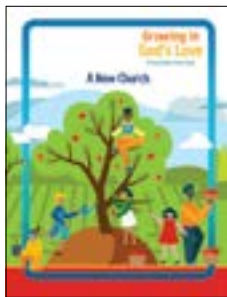

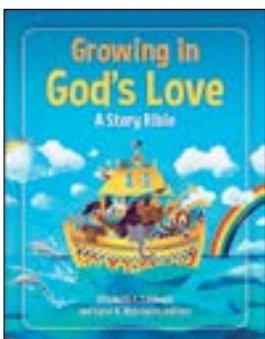

THREE YEARS OF LEARNING ADVENTURES

Growing in Grace & Gratitude embraces children in the grace of God through engagement with the Bible. Each session contains age-appropriate opportunities for responses of gratitude through claiming, celebrating, praying, and offering. Colorful illustrations accompany each Bible story to engage children visually.

Beginning with the fall 2024 quarter, *Growing in Grace & Gratitude* will become an undated, quarterly curriculum that continues to provide sessions that seek to recognize God's grace and respond in gratitude. By the fall 2026 quarter, there will be three years' worth of material. All resources will be available only in a downloadable format.

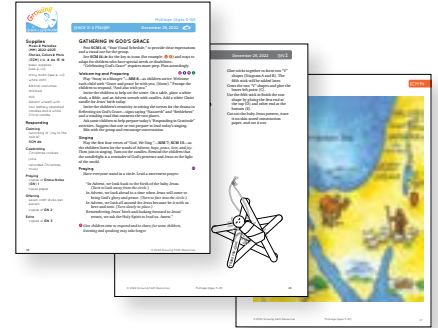
Once a year is released, you can purchase each quarter's sessions at any time and then download them as often as you need. Each of these years will utilize content from previously published sessions.
