Pop-up Bookstores

Pop-up bookstores allow you to have books and curriculum products available for display at your event. When you request a pop-up bookstore at least six weeks prior to your event, we pick books (children's books included) and curriculum products most relevant to your event and ship samples with order forms to you. We offer books at a discount of 35% off full retail price, and some curriculum items will be discounted as well. Pop-up bookstores are designed for events of more than fifty participants, such as regional APCE events and presbytery meetings. Everyone at your event can review the display selections and place orders. Individual orders over \$50 receive free shipping. Church Bookfairs

Bookfairs are a great fundraising opportunity for any church. We work with you to select a display of up to twenty-five books that will be shipped to your church at no charge. Customers can preview the display copies and place orders. All ordered books are shipped to your church for distribution. You determine the discount rate charged to the customer, allowing some profit for the church or charitable organization. You can keep display copies for your church library or sell them to customers.
